#### TO SEE / TO DO

- The cathedral and the cloister: exceptional monuments.
- · Roman amphitheatre, aqueduct and theatre: Roman remains.
- *Villa Aurélienne :* built in 19th century, italian Renaissance inspiration.
- · Chapelle Cocteau: draws of a poet and other artists works, beautiful set of lights through stained-glass.
- · Fréjus city center
- · Archeological museum: history, urban planning, economy and daily life of Roman era.
- Museum of local history: histories of Provence and Fréjus in the 19th and 20th centuries.
- *Port Fréjus*: stroll, watch the fireworks, boat trip with La Brigante
- Base nature beach: big parking, playgrounds, sandy beach and handiplage.
