

ONE DAY IN THE HILLTOP VILLAGES OF PAYS DE FAYENCE



What we call "Pays de Fayence" is big, more than a day will be necessary to discover everything. But, you can have an overview of what we call "Pays de Fayence" in one day with this itinerary which can be adapted to your priorities, your needs and, of course, the time of the year.

HOW TO GO

By car, the fastest way:

From the campsite, take the A8 motorway to Nice, go out exit 39 "Fayence - Les Adrets de l'Estérel". Follow the direction of Montauroux, stop at "La Maison du Lac" which is on your left. Then, follow the road to the village you want to visit.

By car, taking your time:

From the campsite, take the direction of Fréjus by the Nationale 7. Follow the direction of Cannes / Les Adrets (D237). Follow the direction of Montauroux, stop at "La Maison du Lac" which is on your left. Then, follow the road to the village you want to visit.

The MAISON DU LAC is full of information about the Pays de Fayence, open all year long. And, it offers a wonderful view on the lake.

VILLAGES TO VISIT

- · Callian: authentic narrow alleys from a medieval village with its feudal castle in the middle. Enjoy the view on the Estérel and Tanneron massif.
- · Chapelle Notre Dame de la Pitié: on the road between Callian and Mons, this chapel offers a beautiful view on the village.
- Mons: picturesque village, the highest one, enjoy the panorama from Place Saint Sébastien, visit the church Notre Dame de l'Assomption.
- · Tourrettes: an absolute open-air museum, was the home of many artists. Here also an amazing view on the Mediterranean sea.
- · Seillans: One of the most beautiful village in France, perfect for art-lovers.

SAINT CASSIEN LAKE

Stop and have a picnic along the lake. Far from the crowds, we recommend to go to "Le Rocher de l'Américain" (Chemin du Gabinet - 83440 Montauroux). Here, you can swim, chill, rent a stand-up paddle, a pedalo or a canoe and enjoy. Trust Saint Cassien Aventures. They also offer adventure games to do in family around the lake (included in the Pass Côte d'Azur)

The Fondurane bological reserve is on the east side of the lake where you can watch a wide variety of birds, from an observatory. Great activity to do in Family.
